A Menu of Services to Fit your Bandwidth Include:

- Employer Profiles with Resume Dropbox: Send us tailored profiles about your company and what you are looking for, an open call for talent. Students and alumni can submit resumes send automatically to your inbox—choice of receiving one bulk email or individual resumes.
- Employer Branding Video: Share any existing video content that we can share on our social media platforms. We can create a resume dropbox for students/alumni interested in working with you.
- Employer Chat: Sit down with a Manhattanville representative over Zoom to record a quick interview talking about your organization, how to be successful, and what you look for when recruiting new talent. Videos will be shared with the Manhattanville community to increase your presence and attract talent.
- Information Session: Sessions range from 30 to 90 minutes long and consist of a company presentation where current employees explain the values and mission of the company, recent projects, company culture, and their hiring process, followed by a Q&A and an opportunity for students to network with you.
- Instagram Takeover: Temporarily take over our Instagram account to build brand awareness among students and promote other recruitment activities.
